Mount Olive Health Department is offering a Female Cancer Screening at the Medical Clinic in the Health Department from 5:30 pm-7:30 pm

The screening includes a Thin-Prep Pap test, cervical and pelvic exam, manual breast exam and referral for a discounted mammogram. Female residents of Mount Olive, Netcong and Mount Arlington are welcome with preference given to those without insurance coverage.

Women aged 21-29 should have a Pap test every 3 years.

Women aged 30-65 years should have a Pap test
